**Fees are \$25 first \$21 second entry \$17 third entry same dog same day** and include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 for first run and \$3 for each additional run per dog.

Catalog: \$10.00 a limited number of catalogues are available for purchase at the trial. Please pre-order catalogs using entry form.

**PAPER ENTRIES ONLY** A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must include postage or be metered and be delivered by a multi-state/multi-national postal or carrier service including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. All jumps will be displaceable. There will be no obstacle familiarization.

### RAFFLE ITEMS NEEDED

## RIBBONS AND AWARDS:

\*Highest Scoring Dog In Trial,\* Highest Scoring Champion of Record,  
\*Highest Scoring Phalene and \* Highest Scoring Junior Handler will receive  
a Rosette plus Soft Crate and Custom Art Work by Jill Blum.

Handlers must sign up dogs to be eligible for these \* awards by 9:00 am.

Rosettes will be awarded for first through fourth place dogs in each class and jump height. Green qualifying rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Rosettes will also be offered for Double Qualifying dogs (applies to qualifying in Excellent B in both Standard and JWW) & for new titles completed at this trial. A rosette and bar will be offered for any dog completing a MACH, PACH, or a PAX title at this trial.

**All prizes, awards, rosettes and ribbons must be claimed the day of the trial. No prizes will be mailed.**

The Papillon Club of America reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at their discretion.

## MOVE-UPS

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing (email is acceptable) by 6 pm PST on March 19, 2012.

Moves-ups may be submitted in person during the Boston Terrier trial that is held in conjunction with this event. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (form available on site) and no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends on Sunday March 25th.

## WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of a class. At the judge's discretion, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs are not allowed to compete if they are bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf, or suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

## CLASSES OFFERED

A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club (8051 Arco Corporate Dr Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390) or from the AKC web site ([www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org)). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. **Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).**

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial classes:  
8 inches for dogs 11 inches & under at the withers or 4" Preferred  
12 inches for dogs 14 inches & under at the withers or 8" Preferred  
16 inches for dogs 18 inches & under at the withers or 12" Preferred  
20 inches for dogs 22 inches & under at the withers or 16" Preferred  
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers or 20" Preferred  
26 inches at the owner's request

**All Dogs without height cards must be measured by the judge.**

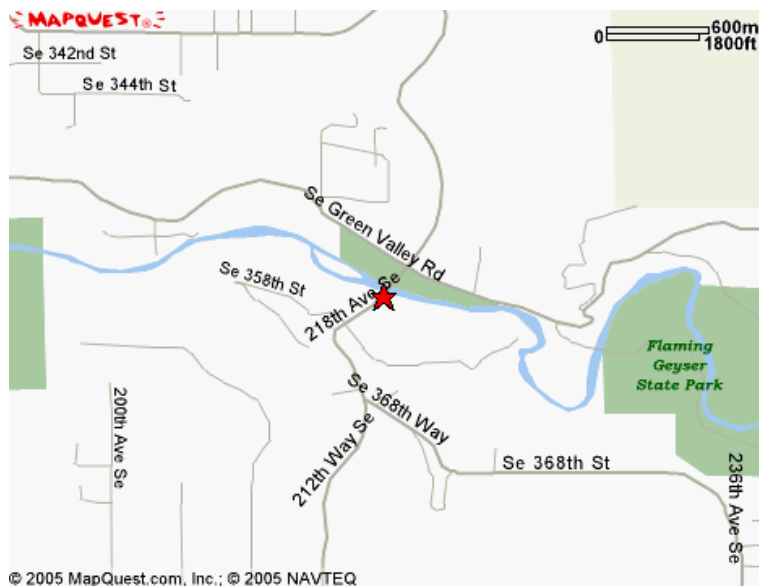
### Driving Directions to Argus Ranch:

#### **FROM NORTH/SOUTH I-5 OR SR-167**

- Exit **HIWAY 18 EAST**
- Exit **AUBURN-BLACK DIAMOND ROAD EAST** keep right
- **RIGHT** at **SE GREEN VALLEY RD** (just past Neely Mansion)
- Follow Green Valley Rd **APPROXIMATELY 7.5 MILES**
- **RIGHT** onto **212<sup>th</sup> Way SE** (Christmas tree farm on the left)
- First **LEFT** into Argus Ranch driveway Follow signs for parking

#### **FROM SR-196 SOUTHBOUND**

- **RIGHT** onto **ROBERTS DR** (in front of coal car)
- Follow Roberts Dr **APPROXIMATELY 4 MILES**
- **LEFT** at **218<sup>TH</sup> ST**
- Bottom of the hill is **STOP SIGN**

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

- ◆ **All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.** AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- ◆ **The safety of dogs is of primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ◆ Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent via email if one is provided to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. **If an exhibitor has not received from the trial secretary a copy of the schedule and confirmation of entry at least seven days prior to the show, contact Theresa Calter** (Theresa@K9EventsNW.com or (206) 282-6503). Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- ◆ Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or emailed entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of **AKC forms without the signed agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.**
- ◆ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee or the AKC. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed for reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ◆ The Papillon Club of America, Argus Ranch, K9 Sports and K9 Events NW assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

- ◆ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**It is a requirement of the AKC, the club and the facility that dogs be on leash at all times except in designated off-leash areas.**

**Owners must clean up after their dogs or they may be barred from further trials.**

#### CONFIRMATION PROTOCOL

If an email address is provided, an email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing, 48 hours after the trial closes and for every move-up or correction. You need to have your filter set to allow email with attachments from **theresacalter@k9eventsnw.com** . Paper confirmations will only be sent when an email is not provided. To help overcome the time it takes for USPS delivery, please check after closing at **www.K9EventsNW.com** under **Upcoming Trials** for details about this trial's judging order, entry statistics, worker schedule and general information.

You may make any changes necessary to your entry before closing but after closing, the secretary may only process move-ups (not moving down to a lower level nor switches between regular and preferred tracks) and corrections to dog/owner/handler information.

OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for checking each dog's entry and information each time it is sent and contacting the trial secretary immediately if a correction/change needs to be made. All changes and corrections must be submitted in writing and email is preferable (theresacalter@k9eventsnw.com ).

Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial along with your dog's AKC jump height card otherwise the database is the final authority for the day's information.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
